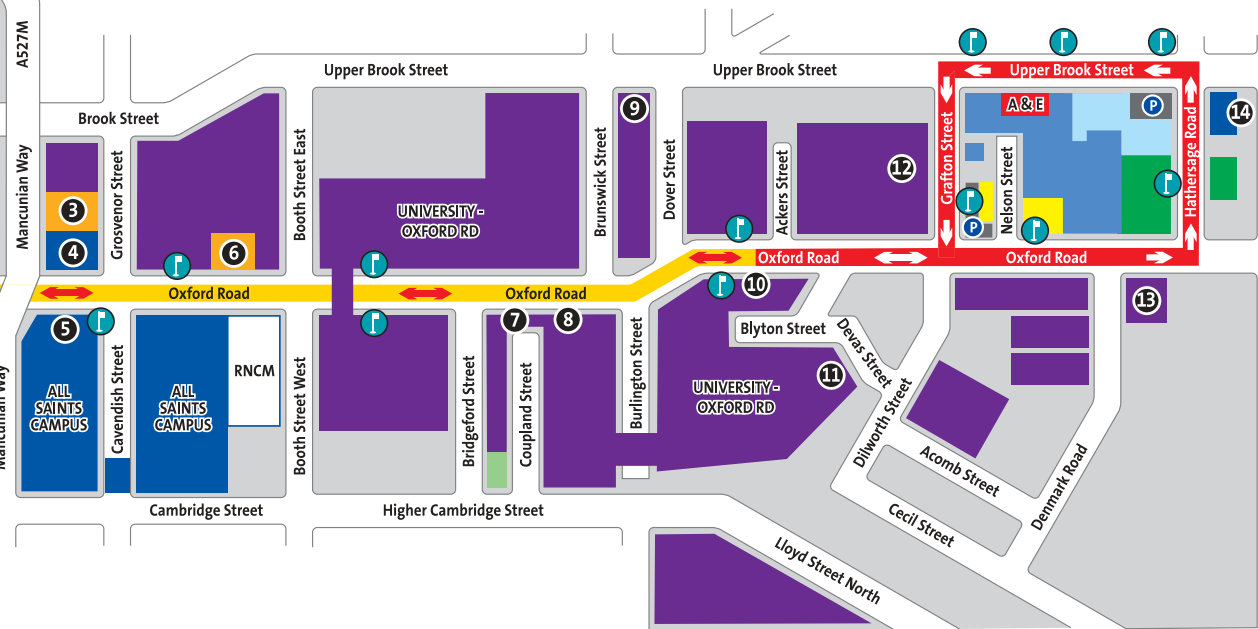


The 147 Extended Route

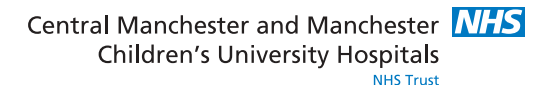

A High Frequency Bus Service Linking Piccadilly Rail Station with Central Hospitals and Universities & Oxford Rd

From 20th February 2006 the 147 service will be improved and the route extended to serve both the Universities along Oxford Rd, the Royal Northern College of Music, the Royal Eye Hospital, the Manchester Royal Infirmary and Saint Mary's Hospital. The frequency of the service will also be increased to 10 minutes throughout the day.

The new service is part of a scheme jointly set up by Manchester Metropolitan University, The University of Manchester, Royal Northern College of Music and the Central Manchester and Manchester Children's University Hospitals NHS Trust, to make it easier to leave your car at home and travel to your destination on public transport.

The fully accessible single decker buses are operated by Bullocks Coaches. They are available for staff, students, visitors and members of the public to use throughout the day, at a low-priced flat rate fare.

The Extended Route The 147 bus service starts from bus stop C, outside the Fairfield entrance to Piccadilly Rail Station and drops off at existing bus stops along the route.

Piccadilly Rail Station – Travis St – Fairfield St – Whitworth St – Sackville St – Charles St – Oxford Rd – **Hathersage Rd** – Upper Brook St – Grafton St – Oxford Rd – Charles St – Sackville St – Whitworth St – Piccadilly Rail Station.

Operating Times

The service operates between **7.15 am - 6.51 pm**.

Monday - Friday every 10 minutes during peak periods.
